

**Pre-K3 through 7th GRADE
SCHOOL CONTRIBUTION POLICY
2017-2018**

St. Katherine of Siena Parish has a proud history of support for Catholic education. One of our true blessings, are the parishioners who support Catholic Education, long after their children have graduated. Because of them, and other donors, we are able to keep tuition reasonable and affordable.

The SKS Tuition Policy states that each family, in addition to their tuition, is ***required to contribute*** at least \$250 in the weekly Sunday collection. This policy runs from July 1, 2017 to June 1, 2018. This gives every family 48 Sundays to contribute the \$250. This figure breaks down to \$5.21 per week. Families not fulfilling this obligation by June 1, 2018 will be charged the non-participating tuition rate for the upcoming school year.

This contribution is to be given
through the family contribution envelopes.

These envelopes are mailed to
each family every two months.

School families are also *asked to contribute* to the following collections:

Block Collection - \$125.00

Christmas Collection - \$50.00

Easter Collection - \$50.00

Grade school students will be given a box of children's envelopes to be used as a way of instilling in them a desire to become personally responsible for the continued success of Saint Katherine's parish. Although no monetary amount is asked for through these envelopes, the offering shows sacrifice and good will.

The reason for this is simple: With the responsibility of getting their children ready for graduation and preparing them for high school next year, many families forget their financial obligation to the parish since their children are leaving St. Katherine's.

These envelopes are mailed to
each family every two months.

School families are also *asked to contribute* to the following collections:

Block Collection - \$125.00

Christmas Collection - \$50.00

Easter Collection - \$50.00

Parents not fulfilling this obligation by March 1st will be notified in writing that their child will not be permitted to participate in any of the activities associated with graduation such as the 8th grade trip, Graduation Mass and Ceremony and the Graduation Dance. Nor will the student's records be forwarded to any high school until all financial obligations are satisfied.

8th grade school students will be given a box of children's envelopes to be used when they attend weekly Sunday Mass, as a way of instilling in them a desire to become personally responsible for the continued success of Saint Katherine's parish. Although no monetary amount is asked for through these envelopes, the offering shows sacrifice and good will.
